5	Epiphysterinum	Tissue of fibrous tumour of uterus.
6	Influenzinum	Nosodes of influenza
7	Medorrhinum	Urethral discharge of gonorrhoea patient.
8	Morbillinum	Nosodes of measles.
9	Parotidinum	Nosodes of mumps.
